Review of Galatians Chapter 1

- 1) Paul wrote this to the "churches in Galatia" which is a region in southern Turkey. This was written around AD 48.
- 2) Paul is dealing with a significant issue of false teaching that is infiltrating the churches.
- 3) Paul is ticked off!
- 4) The Gospel vs. a false Gospel
- 5) I think the "big idea" of the passage is simply – Paul's authority comes from Jesus and only from Jesus and He is only interested in serving Jesus, not pleasing people.

Now read **Galatians 2:1-10**

What immediately stands out?

Look for "so that's" "therefore's" and "for's"

What immediately doesn't make sense?

What is the "big idea of the passage"...what does the author seem most concerned about communicating?

How does this apply to your life?

Why do you think Paul uses the language of slave vs. free in verse 4?

Do you see any teaching in our culture that threatens our freedom in Jesus? What is it?

Why do you think God chose Paul to take the Gospel to gentiles or non-Jewish people?
