THIS WEEKEND

October 1/2, 2011 | "History of the World (pt. 2)" | Speaker: Jim Burgen

Just like anything in history, occasionally it is good to stop and look around and make sure that we haven't drifted off course of our original purpose or direction. In order to do that, we have to do some "excavating". We have to dig away all of the layers and layers of "stuff" that tend to accumulate, cover up, and bury the original model. It's the same with our lives, our faith, and our church. In this series, we will look back at the original model and ask ourselves if we are still on course.
