1. Did your family have any Easter traditions when you were growing up? What were they?
2. What is your favorite Easter candy?
3. What's your earliest memory of Easter?

Core:

1. What has been your experience with the church during your life?
2. Could you relate at all to Jim's "camp experience" of being told that one day all your sins will be played on a screen for everyone in front of God?
3. How do you think the story of Easter is most often communicated to people?
4. In what ways have you found yourself being shaped or defined by your past?
5. How does the story of David and Bathsheba (2 Samuel 11) illustrate what God wants to do with our past?
6. Before this weekend would you have been able to describe why Jesus' death on a cross and resurrection was the remedy to our sin and separation from God?
7. Jim said, if he could rename Easter he would call it "switch day". Why would that be an appropriate name?
8. Read 2 Corinthians 5:21 together as a group. In what way is Jesus "becoming" our sin different from dying for our sin?
9. How does God see your past?
10. How should the way God views you and your past affect your current circumstances and your future?
