Weekend Discussion Questions
February 16-17, 2008

Community:

- 1) Talk about some of your negative experiences with gravity.
- 2) When was the first time you went skiing?
- 3) Do you ski now? Do you snowboard? Why is one better than the other?
- 4) What's your favorite ski resort in Colorado?
- 5) What's the most challenging run you have ever navigated?

Core:

- 1) What have been some of the major decisions you've had to make in your life and how did you make them?
- 2) Did you feel equipped to make your last big decision? What criteria do you use to make decisions?
- 3) Have you ever asked the question, "What's God's will for my life?" If so, how did you go about discovering that?
- 4) Have you ever felt like God is hiding his will from you? If so, Why?
- 5) Have you ever operated under the assumption that if you step out of God's will that your life will get harder, or that God will somehow punish you?
- 6) Why do we assume that?
- 7) This weekend we talked about God's sovereign will, moral will and personal will. Does knowing those exist help you in your decision making process? How?
- 8) We talked about transitioning from asking the old question, "God what do you want me to do?" to asking a new question, "God what are you doing?". What impact would asking this question have on your decision making?
- 9) Were you surprised that I said, "God's number one priority, purpose or will is for us to worship Him"? Why or why not?
- 10) How would you define worship?
- 11) Read Colossians 3:23. How does this give a broad definition to worship?
- 12) Do you agree or disagree with the statement, "we are all worshippers"? Why or why not?
- 13) How have you seen the natural gravitational pull of worship impact your life?
- 14) Read Acts 17:16-28. What similarities do you see between the people of Athens then and us today?
- 15) Read Romans 11:33-36 and 12:1. How can we take our whole lives and offer them as an act of worship to God?
- 16) How does the question, "how does this decision reflect the worth of God?" impact your decision making? Think of decision you've made where you didn't ask that question, would asking it have changed the outcome of the decision?
- 17) Read Romans 1:25. Do you ever feel like you've traded truth for a lie?
- 18) If God's overwhelming purpose for all of us is to worship Him, then where will we ultimately find satisfaction?



Challenge:

- 1) As a group memorize Romans 12:1
- 2) If you have a significant decision in front of you right now, run it through the filter of this question, “How does this decision reflect the worth of God?” Take this week to consider that one question.
