Weekend Discussion Questions
July 26-27, 2008

Community:

1. Would you consider Baseball the sport that represents America? Why or why not?
2. Should performance-enhancing drugs be allowed in professional sports? Why or why not?

Core:

1. Why is it important to care about the things Jesus cared about and to do these things in the way He did them? Can we do them in our own way?
2. Scott summarized the value “Gifted Service” in a sports analogy type way. What was his short definition?
3. Read Acts 6:1-7. Already the leaders of this new following are facing criticism as the group grows? Should the widows’ “needs” be the group’s responsibility? Why?
4. In verse 2 the apostles respond to the complaint by saying, “It would not be right for us to neglect the ministry of the word of God in order to wait on tables.” Was this response wrong or arrogant? What value, if any, do you believe this response had?
5. In our church today what are some of the expectations people might have of Flatirons and its leadership? Should Jim and Scott attempt to meet these expectations? Why or why not?
6. As the twelve apostles communicated their solution to the people in verse 3 and 4 why do you believe the idea was unanimously approved? Would the same be true today if this decision was made in our culture? In our church? Why or why not?
7. Scott pointed out that many times people want to serve or volunteer in a position that they are best fit for. Why do many of these people refuse to play the game if they’re not placed in their “wanted position?” How might this mindset affect Flatirons as a whole?
8. What might be two to three factors that dissuade people from serving?
9. If people opt not to serve/volunteer at Flatirons what will eventually be the end result? What if most everyone who called Flatirons home decided to serve/volunteer in some form or fashion?

Challenge:

1. If you currently aren’t serving or volunteering at Flatirons what inhibits you from doing so? How can these obstacles/challenges be removed so that you might serve? What changes in your own life do you believe would occur, if any, by volunteering/serving?
