**Core:**

1. How does the theme "move" show up in art, film and story?
2. How does the theme "move" show up when we celebrate Christmas?
3. Do you think Jesus would be a popular teacher today?
4. How has the theme "move" showed up in your life?
5. Read Isaiah 7:14. Immanuel means "God with us". How long did the people of Israel have to wait for that promise to come to fruition?
6. Have you ever felt like you are waiting on God to move? Is there something you are waiting on God to do now?
7. Read Matthew 1:20-23. Jim said "the first reason we are so fascinated with Christmas is because every year we are forced to wrestle with the question, "Is that true?" Do you wrestle with that question?
8. If God really moved, came to this earth, lived, served, died and rose again, what impact should that have on our life?
9. Read Philippians 2:1-11. How does this describe Jesus' attitude and behavior? What does it say about our attitude and behavior?
10. Who do you need to say "thank you" to? Who do you need to serve? Who do you need to honor?
11. What would it take for your attitude to reflect the attitude of Jesus beyond Christmas?
12. Do the words, "servant, humble and obedient" describe you?
