Weekend Discussion Questions  
December 3-4, 2011

**Community:**

1. Who in your life would you say is the person you trust most?
2. What is it that makes them trustworthy?

**Core:**

1. If you believe that God sent his Son to earth and then allowed him to be murdered in order that we might be restored to right relationship with God, how does that affect your ability to trust God?
2. If you're totally honest, what are you leaning your faith against right now?
3. Have you ever had a time in your life when your faith was shaken because of something God didn't do or prayers that weren't answered the way you hoped? Why is it more important that God deals with our sin and reconciles us to him than anything else He could do for us?
4. Romans 8:33 says God has justified us or paid for all our sins, past and future, through the death of Jesus. What does that tell us about God's level of commitment to us?
5. Can you talk about an experience or circumstance where you really felt you were beyond God's love and forgiveness? Have you been able to lean your faith into God's ultimate gift of Christ?
6. Read Romans 8:35-37. What does it mean to be "more than conquerors" through God?
7. Looking back at some of your struggles, can you talk about a difficult situation that you've seen God use a situation in a way you could not have imagined? What did you learn about the character of God?
8. Is there something you've felt God wanted you to do or was leading you to do, but you've been too fearful to step out and follow His leading?

**Challenge:**

1. Spend some time this week re-reading Romans 8. Talk to God and allow Him time and space to talk to you and help you lean your faith fully into what He's done for us.
2. If there's something you know God is leading you to do, or to change in your life, take some initial steps in faith.
