Weekend Discussion Questions

April 10-11, 2010

## Community:

1. Is there anything that you have collected all your life?
2. Is there anything you have wanted all your life?
3. Is there anything you have avoided all your life?

## Core:

1. Read John 10:10. What does this tell us about Jesus' motives for anything He says and does?
2. Read Romans 8:32. What does this tell us about what God has already done for us? How should that impact our expectations of what He might do in the future?
3. How does the story of Jesus turning water into wine impact the way you view God?
4. Jim referred to Jesus feeding over 5,000 people in a miraculous way. What is it in your life that you think is impossible because you don't see "how" it could happen? What does this story teach us?
5. What are you worried about right now? Read Matthew 6:34.
6. Jim said "Jesus can make sick things well, and bring dead things back to life". What in your life is sick or dead?
7. How do you know when its time to move on? Let something go or keep pursuing a remedy or restoration?
8. How do the stories Jim talked about (the man born blind in John 9, or bleeding woman in Luke 8 or Lazarus being raised to life in John 11) impact the way you view your life?
9. Since the man born blind, the bleeding woman and Lazarus all died (in Lazarus' case, again) what do you think was the ultimate meaning behind what Jesus did for them?
10. Read Hebrews 4:16. What does this mean? How is all of this about Jesus providing mercy and grace?
