Core:

1. Read Matthew 20:17-28. What stands out to you the most about what Jesus said to the disciples?
2. How would you have responded to James and John?
3. How did Jesus demonstrate both his purpose and his personality?
4. How do the words “slave” and “servant” illustrate Jesus’ purpose and personality?
5. Scott said, Gifted Service is “seeking God’s will by using what you have and what you can do to serve the needs of others”. How do the two parts of this definition reveal how we should serve one another?
6. What have you been uniquely gifted to do? How are you using that to serve the needs of others?
7. What can you do that needs to be done?
8. Scott said that the most important question is not what are you gifted to do, but instead, what needs to be done. Agree or disagree?
9. How did Jesus demonstrate serving the needs of others?
10. Why do you think Jesus chose to come to this earth as a bondservant/slave? Read Philippians 2:6-7.
11. Read Philippians 2:5. What reaction do you have to that command?
12. What do we allow to prevent us from serving one another?
13. Why is it important that we serve one another?
