Weekend Discussion Questions

May 28-29, 2011

Community:

1. Who was the first person to point you to Jesus, and what did that look like?
2. Were there any *weird things* about the Christians you first encountered that got in the way of coming to, and understanding, Jesus? What were they?
3. When was the first time you were invited to “come and see” Flatirons?

Core:

1. Read John 1:36-39. Why does John the Baptist call Jesus “The Lamb of God”? And what did that mean to the people John said this to?
2. What do you make of the two disciples (Andrew and John) dropping everything and following Jesus?
3. Jesus told Andrew and John to, “Come and see.” What were some of the great things they were going to experience by *coming and seeing*? What were some of the tough things they would experience? How can you relate to them in their experiences?
4. Read John 1:41. Discuss some of the reasoning behind Andrew’s actions here.
5. What can we learn from Andrew’s approach to sharing Jesus with his brother Simon (Peter)?
6. Read John 1:43-51. Who do you relate to the most in this section, and why?
7. Have you ever tried pointing someone to Jesus, only to have them respond the same way as Nathanael? How did you react to them? Would you have done anything differently?
8. Read John 2:1-11. What do you see as the main point of this story?
9. What does this story tell us about Jesus’ attitude toward the *small things* in our lives? What are some *small things* Jesus has taken care of for you?
10. Jim shared that we don’t have to have everything about Jesus figured out. What are some things about Jesus you still struggle with?

Challenge:

1. Find someone in your life who you know would really benefit in “bumping into Jesus” and invite them to *come and see* next week.
2. If you really don’t have anyone in your life right now who needs Jesus, ask God to send someone into your life (this week), someone you can help point the way to Jesus.
