Community:

1. Did you ever play on or around train tracks as a kid?
2. Have you ever traveled by train? Where did you go?

Core:

1. Read John 5:19-24. What does Jesus' statement in verse 19 tell us about knowing and understanding God?
2. What is the outcome of aligning our lives with God's truth?
3. How well do you typically respond to authority?
4. Who's authority are you living under right now?
5. What would it look like to live your life under Biblical Authority?
6. Do you know much about what the Bible has to say about the important parts of your life? How would you go about discovering that?
7. Have you ever considered that your ability to do what God wants you to do is directly connected to the amount of time you spend listening to what God has to say (in the Bible)?
8. Can you think of a time when you thought you were on the right track but it ended up in a train wreck?
9. Think about the direction of your life right now. If it keeps heading in this direction where will it end up? Do you want that to become reality? If not, what needs to change?
10. Read John 8:31-35. Do you really believe that Jesus wants us to be free? What do you think freedom would feel like?
